Coach's Notes



Race Day Schedule:

7:30am-9:30am—Registration/Bib Pick-Up

9:45am: Course Closed

10:00am: Boys 5K Classical 15sec individual start

11:15am: Girls 5K Classical 15sec individual start

Approx. 12:30pm: Awards in front of yurt

Course Info:

The course is a three lap course. It is the same course as the Quarry Rd Scrambler race.

Always ski in the direction of the race course. Skiing in the opposite direction will result in a disqualification. Absolutely no walking on the course. Only walking is allowed on the field on the ungroomed snow. This is a three lap course. Racers who do not ski the required number will be disqualified.

The course is closed during the race. All warm-up and cool downs need to be done on foot. Unfortunately, there will not be much time between the boys and girls races for wax testing.

Course access is in front of the yurt. Absolutely no jumping fences.

Technique:

This is a classical race. No skating is allowed except skate turns (where no track is set) and when changing tracks, in which case the competitor is allowed one skate out and one skate back in. A skier will be disqualified if he/she obviously ignores a stop skating warning of an official or he/she receives a second stop skating warning by an official. There will be no marked technique zone.

Other Rules:

The use of freestyle skis is prohibited. Fluoro free glide and kick wax only.

****Request from Quarry Road: any team/individual that's staying to ski after noon pay \$5 per skier for a trail pass (payment can be made in the yurt), and that they leave the venue by 2:30pm.**

Registration:

Registration/bib pick-up is located inside the yurt. Registration is 7:30-9:30am. Coaches report any scratches. If there are racers to be added to the start list, they will go at the end of the start list. Hopefully, there will be very minimum amount of additions. There is no change to start order on race day.

Parking:

Bus parking is in the parking lot next to the stadium.

****All spectator parking is before the yurt. Absolutely no spectator parking in the lot next to the stadium.**

Restrooms:

There are porta-potties available.

Concessions:

Unfortunately, there will be no concession stand.

Results:

Results will be posted on the outside of the yurt. Protests must be submitted by the coach. Protests must be made within 30 minutes after the official results have been posted. Results (along with photos) will be posted on the MHSS website and be sent to area newspapers.

Awards will take place in front of the yurt as soon as results become official (approximately 12:30pm). There will be an announcement indicating the award ceremony start.

Other:

****Request from Quarry Road: any team/individual that's staying to ski after noon pay \$5 per skier for a trail pass (payment can be made in the yurt), and that they leave the venue by 2:30pm.**
