



Leavitt Hornet Classic

Welcome to the 2015 Leavitt Hornet Classic at Stark's Hill! Our many thanks to John Weston, Fryeburg Academy, and the crew at Stark's Hill for hosting the race. Here is some important information to make this meet successful.

**Time:** 10:30am Boys | 12:00pm Girls. Individual start, 15sec intervals.

**Course Info:** 4.91K Classical See course map on website. The course will be groomed and set by Friday evening (sooner if possible). Course will be single track, best line, with 3 tracks to the finish.

The course will close 10 minutes prior to each race. Only coaches will be allowed on course. Always ski in the direction of the race course.

**Race fee:** Due to the change in location, the race fee is now \$7 per racer. Check payable to Leavitt Ski Boosters.

**Parking Info:** There will be parking officials that will instruct where to park buses. Buses may drop off athletes at the trailhead. Officials will park in a small lot closest to the trails. The next two lots are for teams and buses (can usually fit 8 buses here). After that, the remaining buses, parents, and spectators will about around some industrial buildings about a 2 minute walk from the trails.

**Stadium:** The stadium is about 400' in from the trailhead. Team can set up in the stadium. A portable sled is recommended to transport equipment.

**Waxing Info:** There is no power on site.

**Indoor Facilities:** There is no lodge at Stark's Hill. Team buses are needed for shelter. Please come prepared.

The Fryeburg Academy field house will be open. Teams can stop there to use the bathrooms. It is about a mile from the trails. There will be 4 ports-potties at the trail head.

**Registration Info:** Registration will be from 8:30-10:00am. Registration will be at the trail head under a tent.

**Results:** Results will be posted in the stadium. Due to no power at the stadium, printed race results may not be available. Results (along with photos) will be posted on the MHSS website and be sent to area newspapers.

Awards will take place in the stadium area as soon as results become official. There will be an announcement indicating the award ceremony start.
