Welcome, we are excited to be hosting the State Meet once again.

For those that have never been to Stark's before here are the basics:

Our trails are located in an industrial part of town so you will not feel like you are going to a ski race.

**Parking:** Like any event, the premium parking spots are limited and reserved for officials and drop-off. Team buses will be given priority in the innermost lots at the trail head. All other vehicles will be parked in succession around the outskirts. PLEASE DO NOT park around or block the large oil tanks.

Supplies can be dropped off near the trail head but vehicles must then move to the outside parking areas. See map below.

Note: It is a relatively short walk across snowpack to the Start/Finish area, but if you are hauling supplies it will be very helpful to bring a sled.

**Facilities:** \*There is no lodge at Stark's. Your team bus or vehicles will serve as your shelter.  
\*Porta-potties are available at the Trail Head.  
\*There is no electricity available.

**Timing:** Live race timing is available on the stadium monitor outside the timing building and on your phone by visiting [live.starksmountain.org](http://live.starksmountain.org) during the race.

**Spectators:** Are allowed on the course, but only on the edges of the trail.  
Please no dogs or fat bikes on the trails.

**Course & Official Training:**

We will be using the same course for both races. See map below.

It is likely the course will be CLOSED on Saturday 2/16 due to weather.

The race course will be skate groomed and available as the weather allows on Sunday

2/17 from 11:00am to 4:00pm. It will then be closed for grooming.


Course will reopen Monday 2/18 at 9:00am.

Single track, best line with the appropriate scrub areas.





**STARK'S HILL TRAILS:**

**Entering Fryeburg on Route 302 from Bridgton:**

Fryeburg Academy will be on the left as you enter town. Go straight, through the traffic light and take the first left onto Oxford Street at the Norway Savings Bank. Oxford Street will immediately fork, bear right onto Smith Street and follow to the end (at a sharp turn).

**At the turn:**

Teams, Buses & Drop Off will head toward B & C Collision Center and continue toward the trailhead (it will not look like you are going to a ski course).

Parents & Spectators will turn left and park in one of the designated areas around the industrial buildings.
