

Maine Principals Association Class "B" and Class "C" Alpine State Championships

February 16th and 17th, 2015

Bigrock Mountain is pleased and excited to host the 2015 Class "B" and Class "C" High School State Alpine Ski Championship. Our planning process is under way, and we know that you are also beginning preparations for the event. We are confident that your visit to our Central Aroostook County venues will meet all your expectations.

Bus Drop Off and Parking

Upon arrival all team buses will be directed to drop off your racers at the drop stations located at either end of the main lodge. Once all the athletes and coaches are dropped off, buses will be directed to our bus parking lot at the southeast end of our facility.

Coaches and athletes should be prepared to be on the hill at 7:30 am on Monday and Tuesday for course inspection. The ski lift will be open at 7:15 each morning for racers and coaches.

Lodge Access

In addition to our main lodge we have rented a 30' x 30' heated tent to help with space and crowd control. We are asking all the racers and coaches to store their race bags and equipment in the heated tent adjacent to the lodge. The tent will be for racers and coaches only and closed off to the rest of our customers. Each team will have a designated space inside the tent. We would like to have the lodge for our day traffic customers and spectators of the race.

We ask that teams and parents refrain from bringing crock pots/slow cookers into our facility. Power is limited in the lodge and multiple crock pots/slow cookers could create a power problem and a fire hazard. Access to both the race tent and main lodge will be available at 7:00 am each morning.

Lift Tickets and Passes

Tickets and passes for coaches, racers, and team members will be handed out at the Coaches meeting each morning. Racers must either have a bib on or their lift ticket on to be able to ride the ski lift. Lift tickets for Monday February 16th and Tuesday February 17th will be \$20.00 per day per student with coaches skiing for free (Limit of 2 coach's tickets per team). Bigrock will bill the schools directly for lift tickets. Volunteer and Race Officials tickets and passes will need to be picked up at the information desk in the main lodge. Volunteers should check in at 7:45 am each morning at the information desk.

Coaches Meetings

Each morning there will be a coaches meeting in the Bigrock Rental Shop to go over any coaching questions and address all pertinent information regarding the day's events. The coaches meeting is coaches only, not racers or parents.
